The Old Fort Declaration embodies the joint commitment of more than 40 of Africa's leading broadcasters to intensify their contribution to the fight against HIV/AIDS in Africa. This historic pledge was the result of a three-day summit meeting of Africa broadcast leaders convened for the purpose of reviewing the contribution of broadcast media to the fight against HIV/AIDS and to explore ways of increasing the effectiveness of HIV/AIDS related communication and programming. The broadcast leaders concluded that broadcast media has a pivotal role to play in helping turn the tide of the HIV/AIDS epidemic in Africa and resolved to redouble their effort.
